



The Local Bourse rebounded by 0.57% amid renewed bargain hunting activity as investors await the presidential result with optimism. At close of trade, the exchange recorded 25 gainers against 8 losers as Bellwethers, such as NB, MOBIL, DANGFLOUR and DANGSUGAR rose by 4%, 1.12%, 9.95% and 3.33% respectively to top the gainers chart. Consequently, the Consumer Goods and Oil & Gas Sectorial gauges increased by 1.26% and 0.05% respectively. Also, the total value increased to N5.55 billion while the year-to-date gain rose to 4.04%. However, the total volume of traded equities shed marginally by 0.75% to 219.80 million units.
