



The NSE ASI moderated by 0.69% amid renewed profit taking activity as uncertainty becloud investors anticipation of the Presidential election results. Tickers such as NESTLE, UBN, FBNH and UBA dwindled by -4.43%, -8.28%, -3.61% and -2.44% respectively. Thus, dragging the Consumer Goods and Banking sector gauges down by -1.57% and -1.18% respectively. Consequently, the year-to-date gain decreased to 3.32%, as did the total value of equities traded by 56.14% to N2.43 billion despite the total volume of traded equities which rose by 46.58% to 322.2 million units.
